**Topic:** Crucial Work in Protecting Turtle Nesting Sites around the Lower Lakes

The Strathalbyn Field Naturalists, formed in 1962, and ever since have met monthly, held field trips and as required focussed on important conservation projects. Their Turtle project has recently expanded from protecting a small Turtle nesting site at Narrung, on Lake Albert to a second location.

Based on their experience, they are creating another fox-proof area at Mosquito Point on Lake Alexandrina. Through cooperation with the landholder this remarkable site will continue to be managed as part of a farming operation, and it will now also be fenced and managed to prevent fox access during the Turtle breeding season; to protect eggs and increase survival of turtle hatchlings.
